

Local Market Nominated for an Alberta Emerald Award for Environmental Excellence

Each year the Alberta Emerald Foundation (www.emerald-foundation.ca) celebrates environmental excellence in Alberta, most visibly by awards in several categories. This year, Grassroots N.W. Environmental Awareness Society, has been nominated in the Community Group category for Brentwood's very own Grassroots Northland Farmers' Market.

Nomination Summary

'Make it, Bake it, or Grow it!' As Grassroots Northland Farmers' Market approaches its 15th season of encouraging regional economic sustainability by promoting local farmers and ranchers, food processors, and crafters, over \$75,000 in proceeds have been recycled back into community environmental projects through Grassroots N.W. Environmental Awareness Society.

Since 1990 a small group of dedicated volunteers in N.W. Calgary, Alberta has organized community recycling drives, published environmental education resources for teachers and children, and supported environmental projects for schools and nonprofit groups. Championing certified organic produce, Calgary's first mid-week farmers' market is managed by volunteers. 'Fresh Market Tuesdays' have grown from 10 to 50 vendors, and over 2000 people per week visit this seasonal market. Partnering with The City of Calgary, local businesses, community associations,

Alberta Agriculture and ENGOs, Grassroots Northland Farmers' Market continues to transform parking lot space into a forum for community building and sustainable environmental practices.


Stay Tuned
